As an Employed Student Nurse Immunizer with Vancouver Coastal Health you will:

- Work under the supervision of a Registered Nurse (RN), Psychiatric Nurse (RPN), or Nurse Practitioner
- Conduct Authorized Immunization Activities in accordance with the resources issued by the BC Centre for Disease Control
- Prepare and administer injections of COVID-19 vaccine, provide post-immunization monitoring of patients.
- Follow the BC Centre for Disease Control Immunization training and policies, advise patients of adverse reactions and contraindications and provide after care instructions and related documentation.
- Follow standard documentation processes for vaccine administration, record statistical immunization data and participate in continuous quality improvement initiatives.
- This position will be required to travel to various locations across the Vancouver Coastal Health region.
- Practice within the context of a client and family centered care model, and in accordance with the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM) and scope of practice as set by the organization's policies, guidelines and clinical practice documents, Immunization Order of the Provincial Health Officer and within own competence.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Education & Experience

- Successful completion of 2nd Year BScN or RPN program or equivalent and continued enrollment in a recognized nursing education program.
- Current registration as an employed student nurse (ESN) or employed student psychiatric nurse (ESPN) with the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM).
- Certification in Basic Cardiac Life Support.
- Proof of completion of theory and lab skill practice for intramuscular injections.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities

- Ability to successfully complete BCCDC Mandatory Immunization Competency courses
- Ability to successfully complete BCCDC Anaphylaxis Management courses
- Ability to successfully complete Health Authority required Dry Ice and Vaccine storage and handling, and Immunization communication courses
- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing and deal effectively with a variety of internal and external contacts including co-workers, patients/residents/clients, and families.
- Ability to perform Basic Cardiac Life Support
- Physical ability to perform the duties of the position.

- Be continually enrolled full-time and in good standing in a recognized school of Nursing Program in BC
- Have successfully completed 2nd year of your BScN or RPN Program
- Have successfully completed an adult med/surg (BScN student) or acute psychiatric (RPN student) rotation prior to your start date
- Be registered/eligible for registration with BCCNM as an employed student nurse (ESN) or employed student psychiatric nurse (ESPN).
- Have current certification in Basic Cardiac Life Support
