## As an Healthcare Student Immunizer with Vancouver Coastal Health you will:

- Work under the supervision of a Registered Nurse or Authorized Registered Health Professional.
- Conduct Authorized Immunization Activities in accordance with the resources issued by the BC Centre for Disease Control and in compliance with the Immunization Order of the Provincial Health Officer.
- Prepare and administer injections of COVID-19 vaccine, provide post-immunization monitoring of patients and respond to reactions.
- Follow the BC Centre for Disease Control Immunization training and policies, advise patients of adverse reactions and contraindications and provide after care instructions and related documentation.
- Follow standard documentation processes for vaccine administration, records statistical immunization data and participate in continuous quality improvement initiatives.
- This position will be required to travel to various locations across the Vancouver Coastal Health region.

- Active student enrollment in a recognized and accredited post-secondary Practical Nursing, Midwifery, Nursing, or Psychiatric Nursing program.
- Completion of theory and lab skill practice for intramuscular injections and withdrawing from a multi-dose vial.
