- The Williams Lake First Nations Wellness Centre (WLFNWC) is a new primary care centre opening to improve access to culturally safe care for First Nations people and their families;
- The Centre's core hours will be from 9:00AM to 4:30PM Monday to Friday.
- The **Nurse Practitioner** will be responsible for practicing with cultural humility, to provide primary care in a culturally safe, team based environment that recognizes the physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual aspects of the client (and family) to provide whole person care, in compliance with policies and procedures of acceptable BC health and wellness regulations and standards.

- You are passionate about supporting First Nations families on their health and wellness journeys;
- You have a Masters Degree – Nurse Practitioner (Family);
- You have an active practicing license in good standing with the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM);
- You have training in Cultural Safety & Humility or are willing to take this training;
- You have experience working with First Nations people and communities and providing culturally safe care.

About this Initiative

The First Nations-led Primary Care Initiative (FNPCI) aims to improve access to primary health-care services for First Nations people across BC in a way that is culturally safe and closer to home. The FNPCI is part of the Province's primary care strategy, which is integrating team-based care in communities throughout B.C. and changing the way primary care is delivered with the creation of primary care networks in partnership with the Regional Health Authorities.

First Nations Primary Health Care Centres

One of the main objectives of the FNPCI is to develop new First Nations Primary Health Care Centres in rural and urban locations across the province. Development will include the enhancement of existing health centres as First Nations Primary Health Care Centres.

The centres will provide access to culturally safe, quality primary health care services for First Nations people and their families. The aim is for clients to feel safe, welcomed, valued, respected and heard when they access care services at one of these centres.
