The First Nations Health Authority is a diverse and transformational health organization of professional, innovative and dedicated team members and leaders. The first of its kind in Canada, FNHA works as a health-and-wellness partner with BC First Nations to support self-determination and decision-making to improve health outcomes.

The students will support the OCMO to begin developing a strengths-based indicator for the Population Health and Wellness Agenda (PHWA) for conceptualizing and measure connection to land and self-determination within a BC First Nations context. The PHWA represents the next 10-year time frame (2020-2030) and a new stage in how the health and wellness of First Nations in BC is monitored, assessed, and reported. The collaborative process between the FNHA and the PHO to develop a new suite of indicators, set targets, and develop reports together is a step forward in reconciliation work in BC and in decolonizing reporting initiatives. The PHWA prioritizes a First Nations perspective and offers a holistic strengths-based approach to First Nations health and wellness. It uses "two-eyed seeing" to use Western data and First Nations teachings, qualitative data, and stories together.
